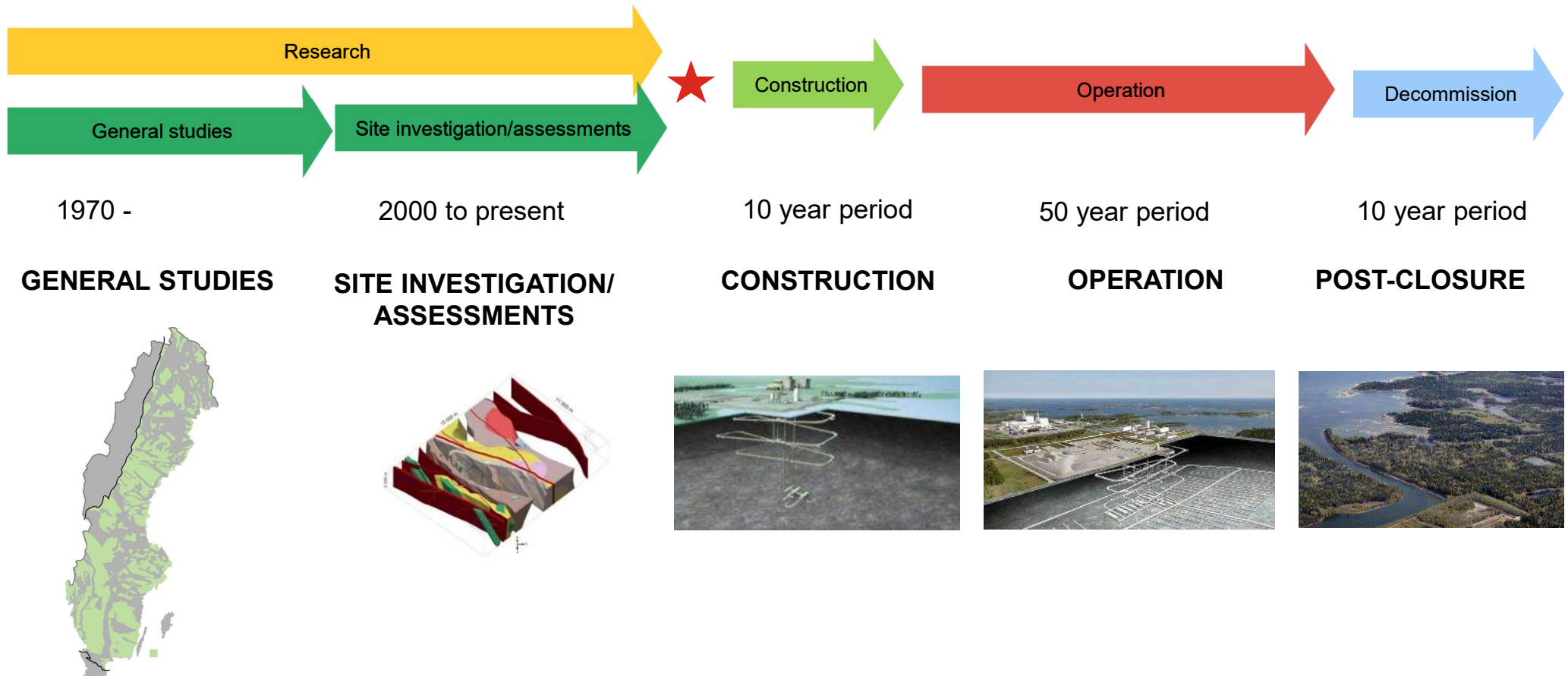

# Need for changes at SKB

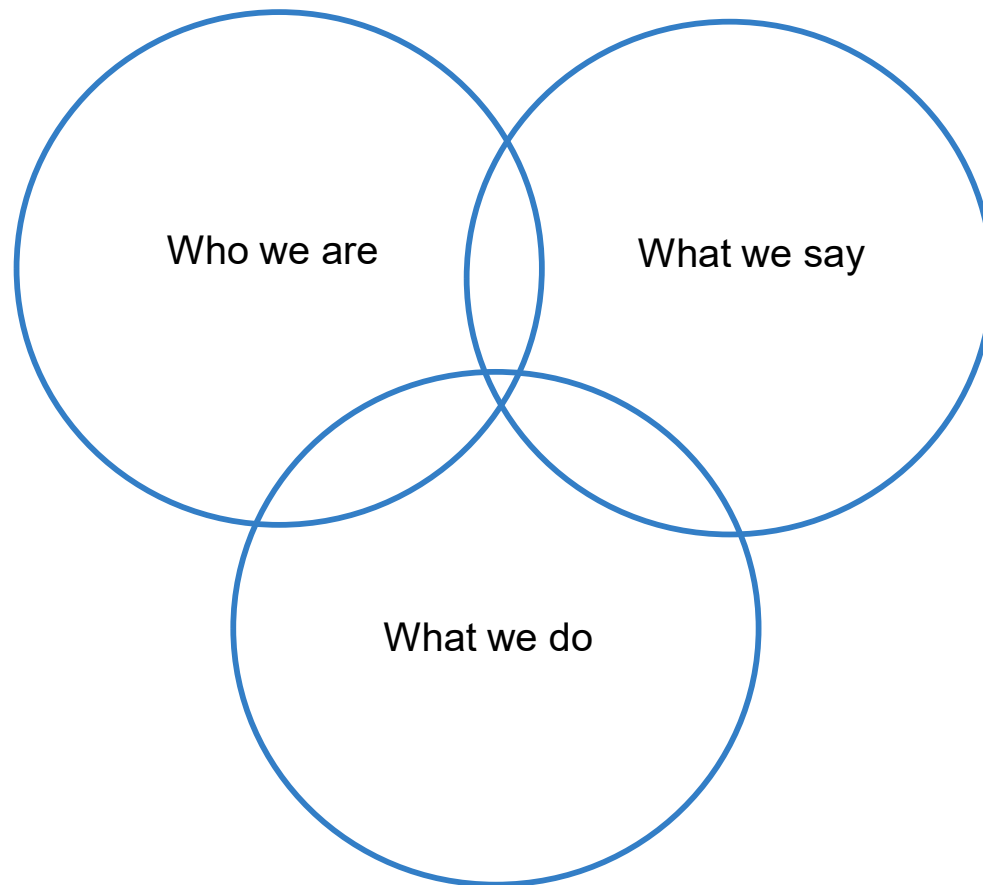
- New competence - Construction
